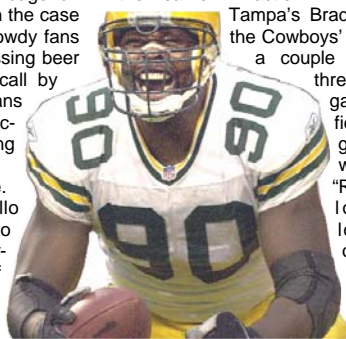

NFL: "Either Stop Throwing Garbage, Or Start Catching It"

Following instances in Cleveland and New Orleans, the NFL is taking a hard stand against anyone who throws garbage on the football field. Such has been the case in Cleveland where numerous rowdy fans were hauled-off by police for tossing beer bottles after an apparent bad call by referees, and then in New Orleans where a copy-cat incident occurred on Monday night resulting several arrests.

But the NFL is not stopping there. NFL spokesman Greg Aiello stated, "We are not going to tolerate anyone... I mean anyone, caught in the act of 'throwing garbage' on the field during a game."

Aiello then read the names of several NFL quarterbacks who he said were guilty of the same infraction. Among them,



Tampa's Brad Johnson and the Cowboys' Quincy Carter, a couple of QB's who threw nothing but garbage on the field during their games last weekend. "Referees have long been looking the other way," said Aiello. "If Joe Fan in the stands goes

to jail for throwing garbage, Brett Favre will too if he does the same... and he came pretty darn close to being hauled away in cuffs last week. His performance against Tennessee last Sunday was pathetic." The league stated it is currently reviewing videotape of a dozen games last Sunday and have already identified 36 unruly fans in the stands and six quarterbacks on the field who they say are "guilty" of "throwing nothing but garbage."

Incidentally, Carolina Panthers QB Chris Weinke currently ranks dead-last of all quarterbacks in the NFL with a passing rating of only 64.4-percent, and if he doesn't improve drastically before the end of the regular season, the league plans to seek the death penalty. ©

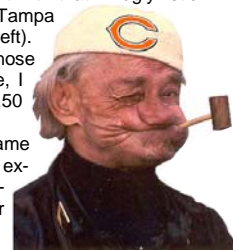
MINN - "At one of our home games, we tried organizing a bottle-tossing at Randy Moss, but there weren't enough fans in the stadium."

Ollie VandenKogel, 35, and his son Jr., 8 were given the choice by the judge, to either spend 60 days in jail and pay a fine, or dress as Bears fans for part of a day. The father decided to accept his jail sentence, his son was forced to take the second option, and on a Friday afternoon in Fondulac, WI, the small boy, dressed in a Bear cap and carrying a moldy Chicago made hotdog, paraded down the street for an hour.

The judge chose the punishment due to the overcrowding of the County Youth facility. ©



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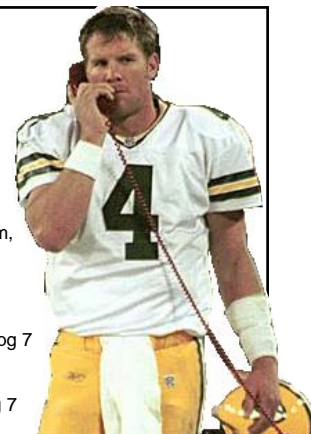

VEGAS ODDS: PACKERS BY 8.5 OVER THE BROWNS AND THE O/U= 38.0

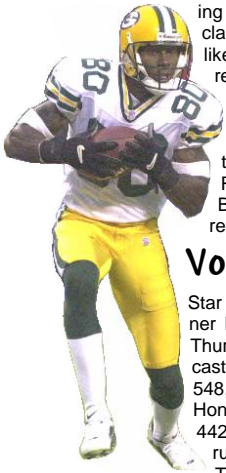

Polish Rapper Under Fire For Use Of The Word 'Polack'

PULASKI, WI— MC Krakow, a popular Green Bay-based rapper of Polish descent, came under fire Tuesday for his use of the word 'Polack' on his new album *Packer Polack Pandemonium*. When MC Krakow casually uses the P-word, it dredges up decades of hurtful portrayals and cruel jokes for our people," said Sandy Serwacki, president of the Polish Anti-Defamation Society. "In just the song 'Ten-Inch Pierogie' alone, he uses the word 27 times." In an official statement, MC Krakow defended his use of the word: "When I say, 'Y'all be my Polacks,' or 'Yo, what up, Polack?,' it's my way of taking the word back. Our people need to reclaim and embrace 'Polack' with pride, just like Eminem did it all for the nookie. In a related story the Chicago Bear fans were outraged at the Happy Schnapps Combo for the lyrics of their song, 'The Bears Still Suck Polka.' The case was later thrown out of court when Circuit Judge Romy Schnozznoskovicz ruled that the Bears not only suck, but they really really really really really suck. ☺

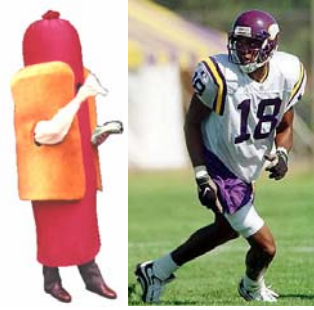


Vote For Favre!

Star quarterbacks Brett Favre and Kurt Warner lead fan voting for the Pro Bowl through Thursday. With more than 34 million votes cast on NFL.com, Green Bay's Favre has 548,614 for the game, scheduled for Feb. 9 in Honolulu. St. Louis' Warner is next with 442,573, followed by his Rams teammate, running back Marshall Faulk (441,237). The leading AFC vote-getter is Pittsburgh Steelers running back Jerome Bettis with 435,419. Oakland Raiders quarterback Rich Gannon rounds out the top five overall with 435,133. Voting continues on the Web site through Dec. 31. Players and coaches will vote on Dec. 26-27. ☺

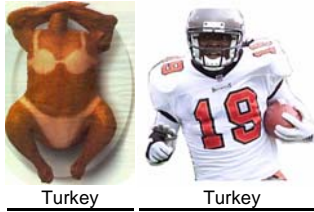
Continuing Packer Education Series

This will be only the 14th game between the Packers and the Browns. The Browns, now in their second "configuration," will be paying their first regular-season visit ever to Green Bay and Lambeau Field.

It will not, however, be their first significant visit to Tittletown. The Browns were on display at "Lambeau" on January 2, 1966, a day on which the Packers defeated Cleveland, 23-12, to capture their tenth National Football League championship - a success that sent the Green and Gold on their way to three consecutive titles...the only "trifecta" under the playoff system in NFL history.

The Packers hold the advantage in the series with 8 wins and 6 losses.

party this evening Please leave in a timely manner after the game-no later than 8pm.

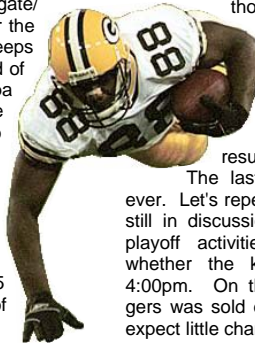
